As you are aware, National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme is for rehabilitation of children withdrawn from work. Under the Scheme, the children (9-14 years) are put into Special Training Centers (STCs), where they are provided with bridge education; vocational training, stipend etc. and they are finally mainstreamed to the formal education system. For effective and smooth implementation of the Scheme, an online portal 'PENCIL' has been developed and being used by District Project Societies under chairmanship of DM/DC of the district.

2. Ministry has introduced online attendance system so that the attendance of the enrolled children can be marked through PENCIL at STC level. The attendance module was tested by some of the districts in month of January, 2019 on pilot basis and accordingly all the District Project Societies were asked to mark online attendance w.e.f. 01st February, 2019 for all STCs. The attendance marked at STC level is also to be acknowledged by the Project Director on daily basis. However, it has been noticed that only few societies are marking online attendance through the Portal.

This online attendance would also be helpful for system based processing of stipend by automatic generation of list of eligible children and uploading the same under digital signature of District Magistrate on monthly basis. All District Project Societies in your State may be directed to use the online attendance system for all the children enrolled in STCs on daily basis.

3. Further, as per the directions of Ministry of Finance, the entire expenditure by all District Project Societies under the Scheme is to be done through the EAT (Expenditure Advance & Transfer) Module of PFMS. Despite repeated trainings and reminders, it has been observed that many of the District Project Societies are not complying with the instructions for expenditure through PFMS. In this regard, all District Project Societies may be directed that every expenditure under the Scheme is done through the EAT Module of PFMS only.

4. In view of the above, I seek your intervention for implementation of PENCIL based attendance system in STCs and also for making expenditure under the Scheme through EAT Module of PFMS only.

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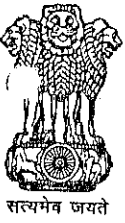

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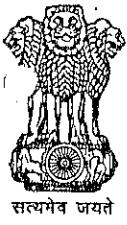

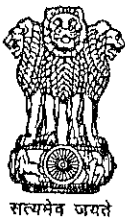
